I am writing to say THANK YOU. Because of your hard work, HB 1114 passed with full \$19.7 million funding. We understand that this legislative session was a difficult one with the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and the call for budget cuts. Yet, you continued to ensure that postpartum Medicaid extension remained a priority and we are grateful for all of your hard work. Due to your efforts, the Department of Community Health is able to submit a waiver to extend the coverage of Pregnancy Medicaid to six months after delivery. Pregnancy Medicaid covers most mothers in Georgia when they give birth. This extension would allow them to receive the care needed to stay healthy during the vulnerable postpartum period and manage physical or mental issues that may have developed during pregnancy.
